









Humidity Tropical climates with increased humidity or heat do cause a reduction in pore size. Follicular cell build up once poor size is reduced will cause comedone formation. This effect can also be seen after a prolonged shower or bath




Papule Raised bump with no visible liquid

Pustule Small inflamed lesions often filled with puss.

Macule Flat markings, not raised, not flat.





Microcemodones



Deep Inflammatory Lesions

(Nodules) Small are 5 - 10 mm and larger up to 2 - 3 cm.

(Deep Pustules) Softer nodules that may be 1 cm or more in size.

Closed comedones (whiteheads)



Open comedones (blackheads)

Oxidation of comedone exposed to air is one theory



(Sandpaper) Closely packed whiteheads

(Submarine) Large 5 - 8 mm comedones
